MISSION

To assist human service, social welfare or other charitable, non-profit organizations in Kennebec County by making an annual donation of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to an agency selected through an application process.

BACKGROUND

The Griffin • Guerrette Charitable Giving Fund was created to recognize Judith A. Griffin and Paul J. Guerrette for nearly seventy years of dedicated service to Trademark Federal Credit Union¹ and to the communities surrounding the Augusta area.

After joining forces in 1986, Judy & Paul formed a productive, compassionate, and inseparable team combining their talents to serve the Credit Union, the members, and their fellow citizens – at work and in their personal lives. Their service provided a constant source of inspiration to their family, friends, colleagues, and acquaintances alike. They richly deserve the recognition the Board of Directors proudly presented to them by establishing this fund in 2012.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- All applicants must complete the application for consideration by the Selection Committee. Eligible candidates will be presented to the Board of Directors and all decisions are at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors and are final.
- Organizations must be located in and primarily serve, the people of Kennebec County

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The following eligibility guidelines were established to assist the fund's Selection Committee.

- All applicants must complete the application for consideration by the Selection Committee. Eligible candidates will be presented to the Board of Directors and all decisions are at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors and are final.
- Organizations must be located in and primarily serve, the people of Kennebec County

Examples of organizations in the Augusta area that meet the eligibility criteria are:

- Big Brothers Big Sisters of Kennebec Valley
- The Children's Center
- Crisis & Counseling Centers
- Family Violence Project

All other Augusta area, non-profit organizations are encouraged to apply for consideration.

Funds may be used to assist an organization's efforts in the following areas:

- Start-up money for an organization or project
- Projects that involve the disabled or economically disadvantaged.
- Hospice care
- Requests from organizations for purchase of necessary equipment or supplies.
- Other uses will be considered by the Committee based on information provided within the application.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

The fund's Selection Committee consists of a minimum of three (3) volunteers who are current members of Trademark Federal Credit Union. This Committee will review applicants for eligibility and will present a final list to the Board of Directors of Trademark for final consideration.

Current members are eligible to serve on the Committee. Anyone interested in volunteering should send their request via e-mail to:

APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS

- The online application must be used to be considered and must be submitted via e-mail to G2Committee@trademarkfcu.org by 5:00 p.m. on August 31.
- The Selection Committee will submit its recommendations to the Board of Directors for final approval.
- The Board of Director's final selection will be announced the first week in November

¹ - Trademark Federal Credit Union was created when Alliance of Maine FCU (formerly Central Maine Power Co. Employees FCU) and Hannaford Associates FCU joined forces in 2010. The credit unions were chartered in 1936.


